TESTIMONIES FOR YOU

<u>GHANA</u> – A pastor and his wife we know in northern Ghana were married for seventeen years without a child, and the wife delivered a set of twin boys last year in August. Our God is amazing!

ETHIOPIA – As I ministered and prayed for people in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, last week, a lady had a lump in her breast, and it disappeared. Jesus heals today!

BOTSWANA – A man gave testimony of how God preserved his family as they traveled. He asked mechanics to check his car very well, before going on a long trip. They found a very bad fault inside an almost new tire, that could have caused a terrible accident!

<u>NIGERIA</u> – A man was bending over, working in his farm, when something snapped in his back. He was in great pain and difficulty, till Jesus miraculously healed him. Now, he's completely well and strong again!

KENYA – A man was sitting between the driver and another passenger in a bus, when the driver suddenly collapsed over the steering wheel. He grabbed the wheel, and the bus was hit by another vehicle. No one was seriously injured, and the driver recovered in the hospital.

SWAZILAND – A lady testified about how I prayed for her last year, when she was so weak that she couldn't even walk. She got very strong, and is working every day on her job.

SOUTH AFRICA – A lady told of how she took her car to the shop for repairs, and the owner didn't charge her anything for all the work he did. He said she had prayed for him, and God had done miracles.

ZAMBIA – A pastor told me how he and his church board had tried to offer a good amount to the Muslim owner of the vacant land next to their church, but he kept refusing to sell it to Christians. When the man went through hard times, he sold the land to a wealthy Hindu man. The church board went to him, and he gave the land to the church for free. God has many ways to answer our prayers!

KENYA – A young man asked me to pray for him before a service, for him to get a good job. Before the service was over, he got a text from a friend about how he should come to an international organization the next morning, as there was an opening there!

BOTSWANA – A lady testified about how I had laid my hand on her the night before, in the exact spot where she was suffering from terrible headaches. Jesus healed her that same minute!

ETHIOPIA – The man of the family I stay with, when I'm ministering in Ethiopia, was put in prison for five months last year. He owns a large printing company, and had printed a book for a friend. The book angered people in high places, causing him and the author to be arrested.

In the far away prison, he began to preach, and there was revival He started a Bible School, and 135 men graduated, wearing caps and gowns! He started a nursery school for all the small children in the prison, as they're there with their mothers, who are prisoners. He hired two teachers, and supplied three good meals every day for them, continuing after his release. God turned the whole bad situation into good, as He promised in Romans 8:28!

<u>GHANA</u> – We continue helping pastors to build churches in the villages and towns in northern Ghana. We dedicated another one that got finished in Kunkwa No. 1, on January 2. We'll dedicate two more in August, at Kologo and Kukua Faith in Tamale. The walls inside and outside are getting plastered at Nasia (No. 60) and Gambaga (No. 61) right now, also they're working on windows and doors, flooring, etc.

Church No. 62 at Gadantinga is in a small village, and is now finished, praise God! They were meeting under a tree, and now have their church! I believe God is touching the hearts of his people to help me to build churches in northern Ghana. Are you ready to send a special offering, and have a part?

PERSONAL NEWS

While I was ministering in northern Ghana in January, I had a bad fall in the northern city of Tamale, the second place we lived so many years ago. I had two fractures, one in my right wrist, and the other in the pubic bone in the pelvis area. I had surgery on my wrist, in a small new orthopedic hospital, and spent a week there. I went through a lot of pain, and really appreciated so many friends who prayed for me, and came to see me, some coming from far places.

Jesus has touched me, and I'm walking very well now without a walking stick, praise God! I'm continuing with physical therapy on my fingers and wrist, till they're fully restored. Thanks for praying!

As always, I'll be in the U.S. to minister in many places, from May 4 till July 13. We'll have the big annual International Service and Supper on Friday evening, June 3, at 7:00 P.M. It's at Faith Assembly of God Church, 3940 Vista Road, in Pasadena, Texas. You're invited!

We'll be remembering my beloved husband, Rev. Arthur E. Hokett, as it's almost five years since God called him home on August 6, 2011. Pray for me, as I work on two new books to get printed. One is "Stories He Loved to Tell, volume 2," and the other is "Words of Hope."
