Now, these things have been put on hold, of course, but we can keep in touch through my <u>monthly E-mail updates</u>, <u>phone calls</u> to my <u>US</u> number (<u>281-471-4109</u>), and my <u>Whatsapp</u> number (<u>+233-244151345</u>).

I'm determined to witness to as many people as I can, as so many are full of fear and anxiety in this time of uncertainty and confusion. I've already been able to pray with two people here to be saved, and to receive Jesus as their personal <u>Saviour</u>. Try your best to tell people about <u>Jesus</u>, too!

Please pray every day for me, and remember my four Prayer Points: <u>God's Anointing</u>, <u>God's Provision</u>, <u>God's Protection</u>, and <u>God's Strength</u>. That's <u>APPS!</u>

Last week, I sent money to two different village churches in northern <u>Ghana</u>, to quickly put a roof on them, and to finish all the plastering of walls inside and outside, flooring, windows, doors, etc., before the heavy rains come very soon. They are at <u>Kasape</u> and <u>Konchin-Gberuk</u>, churches <u>No. 90</u> and <u>91</u>.

We have ten other churches in different parts of northern <u>Ghana</u> in different stages of construction, too. I praise <u>God</u> for the support from <u>God's</u> people in many countries, to help me do the work of <u>God</u>. I praise <u>God</u>, and give <u>Him</u> all the glory!

Yes, the letter "A" is for the month of April, but "A" is also for the word "Awesome," too! I'm praying for God to do something AWESOME in APRIL for you! Trust Him for testimonies this month!
