I was there for over seven weeks, and I was really blessed in all the villages, towns, and cities, traveling everywhere by road.

Thanks for always <u>praying for me</u>, and for <u>giving offerings</u> to have a part in what **God** is doing all over Africa. Please keep on helping me, as I need you so very much, and I also pray for <u>YOU</u>, too!

In this month of **September**, I'll be in the **Lagos** area, and also in **Abuja**, capital of **Nigeria**, in the last part of the month.

Also, we're working on the beautiful new <u>"Thought for the Day"</u> calendar for **2023**, and it will be the 32nd edition of the calendar! It's always printed here in Nigeria, and is in full color, too.

The calendar is always ready by **October 1** every year. I hope you can get a copy from me personally, or see it on **E-mail** or **WhatsApp**, month by month.

We had a bad accident about three weeks ago in northern **Ghana**, when we were driving back from a big church dedication just after dark, and in heavy rain on <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 12</u>. God protected my faithful driver and me, as we felt **His** angels all around us at that very moment!

A 20 passenger bus crashed into us on our left side, then a second crash as it pushed us into a cement gutter beside the road. We weren't hurt, and all the people in the bus were unhurt, praise **God**!

We had turned off the road, planning to stop at a station to wait for the rain to hopefully slacken, so we could continue. The bus driver passed a taxi that had been behind us, and his brakes failed, causing him to crash into us off the road.

We could have been badly hurt, or even killed, but we had our seatbelts on, thank **God**! Just a few more inches, and we would have fallen into the gutter! The wheel under me was hanging over the gutter.

My driver knew the best mechanic in the city we were traveling to, as he lives there. He also knew the best man to work on the body, spray painting, etc, too. After five days of work, we had my car back, and ready to drive for six hours to the next place!

We rented a car to drive for two days, to go to minister in a far place, where we're helping build a church, while the car was being worked on. **God** is so good!!!

God provided every need miraculously, to pay for all the repairs, which were very unexpected. He's so very, very faithful, and He's the **Great Provider**!

We dedicated three more of the churches we're helping the pastors to build in northern **Ghana**: <u>Jininsa</u> <u>on July 30</u>; <u>Mimima on August 12</u>, and <u>Jonshegu (Tamale) on August 13</u>.

We've also started to help a new one in <u>Janania (Church No. 113)</u>, and the roof was finished two days ago! There are two more we'll help in the next few days at <u>Gnani (No. 114)</u> and <u>Zaangum (No. 115)</u>. There are presently six churches under construction in northern **Ghana**. Praise **God** for friends like <u>YOU</u> who help me!

Yes, "<u>S</u>" is for "<u>September</u>," but the letter "<u>S</u>" is also for the word "<u>SUCCESS</u>," too! I'm praying for <u>YOU</u> to see <u>SUCCESS</u> in your <u>marriage</u>, your <u>education</u>, your <u>business</u>, your <u>job</u>, your <u>relationships</u>, your <u>ministry</u>, and <u>every area</u> of your life this month!
