Dear Special Friends,

Hello, on this Saturday evening in Nairobi, Kenya. It's April 6. 2019, and I have three more weeks in East Africa. I'll be in Tanzania next week, and later in the month, in Ethiopia.

I'll be at home again in Nigeria, in the first week of May, to work on all the printed newsletters, to mail out again. It's a huge job twice in the year, taking a whole one and a half weeks, with help from volunteers, who come to my house in Lagos.

Thanks with all my heart for praying for me, as I need it so very much all the time. Thanks also for giving your offerings to help support the ministry, as I depend on you to help me go to the nations.

I was in India till the middle of March, with had many problems and delays to send out my monthly update for March. I kept trying in India and Kenya, finally finishing them all, just last week in Uganda.

It's always a blessing to minister here in Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania every year since 1989. I've heard testimonies in several of the churches, and I praise God.

A man in one place told of how I prayed for his young daughter last year, and she was having pains in her chest, around her heart. Jesus touched her, and all the pain stopped.

A lady gave testimony about how I prayed for her back, and Jesus healed her of the back problem. She also asked me to pray for her to have a child, and God gave her twins!

A young man was invited by a friend to come to one of the services. He had been to a doctor, and was suffering from stomach pains. Jesus healed him that night, and he was praising God.

A lady told of how she had been in a wheelchair for five years, and can now walk very well, since Jesus healed her legs.

I prayed for a lady last year to get a job, and she gave testimony about how she now has an excellent job. God is so good!

In northern Ghana, the roof is on the church at <u>Kobiri</u> (No. 82 in Overseas No. 2). I've received pictures by Whatsapp, and I'm so happy!

This coming week, I'll make bank transfers to help put on a roof at two more places. At <u>Yipaala</u> (Church No. 83, in Overseas No. 1) and at <u>Naiyoko</u> (Church No. 84, near Walewale), the people are getting ready to roof the church soon.

I'm also sending funds to help with plastering walls, flooring, putting in doors and windows, etc., at two more churches, at <u>Zabzoaga</u> (near Zebilla) and <u>Bincheratanga</u> (near Yendi). We've already helped them put a roof on the churches in the past few months.

Also, we're helping with the final wiring at **Kpakayili** (Tamale), for the church dedication, which is set for August 10.

Three more church dedications are also coming up soon, at <u>Tinga</u> (Bole area) on July 27, at <u>Gorogo</u> (near Bolgatanga) on August 3, and at <u>Bisaldo</u> (near Saboba) on August 13.

Thanks so very much for wanting to have a part in helping me build more churches in the villages and towns, all across northern Ghana, where we lived for our first almost eighteen years in Africa.

Remember, this month of April begins with an "A," but the word "Awesome" also begins

with an " $\underline{A}$ ", too. I'm praying for our awesome God to bless you this month, with an  $\underline{AWESOME\ APRIL}$ !
