Hello, while I'm at home in Lagos for a few days. I arrived back in Nigeria last week, after being away since the middle of February, ministering in India and East Africa.

Thanks so very much for praying for me, as I depend on friends like you to pray faithfully. Thanks also for continuing to give offerings to help me to go to the nations as I do.

Every time you sow a seed in the ministry, you're having a part in the work, and it's a **great blessing**! I praise God for special friends everywhere I go, who faithfully give! We're all part of the team that God is using to preach the gospel, pray for the sick, help build churches, etc.

Last month, I was in Tanzania and Ethiopia, plus a few days in Kenya. Later this year, I'll be ministering in southern Africa, in Zambia, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Botswana, and South Africa.

In Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, there were many testimonies! A man testified about how he had taken me to his house two years ago, to pray for his wife.

She had had a terrible fall, and her foot was badly injured, even turned sideways! Jesus has totally healed the foot, and he even showed me a short video taken afterwards, showing her going up and down the stairs, with her foot working perfectly!

A couple came to me after a service, and showed me their little miracle daughter, saying I had prayed for them to have a child!

Another lady in a different place told me how she had bought one of the nice key holders we always have for sale. She got one two years ago, and was praying for her own house. She had registered for an allotment of houses the government was giving out, and was chosen to receive one. She now has her own house, and a house key on the key holder!

A pastor in Tanzania gave a testimony about how he got one of the key holders last year, when he was praying for a car. God miraculously provided a car for him, and his car key is now on the key holder!

A couple in Nigeria, who are partners in the ministry, sent a note, asking me to pray for a miracle. They wanted a child so much, and the wife thought she was pregnant.

The tests showed positive, but a doctor told them there was nothing showing on the scan. I prayed for them, and she went back for another scan. This time, the scan showed the sac in the uterus, and they were told that she was about five weeks pregnant! God answered prayer!

The work on the churches we're helping to build in northern Ghana continues, and I've been able to help four more this month. We've sent funds to help put a roof on at <u>Naiyoko</u> (near Walewale), Church No. 83, and at **Yipaala** (in Overseas No. 1), Church No. 84.

We've also been able to send funds to help with plastering, flooring, windows, doors, etc., at **Zabzoaga** (near Zebilla in Upper East Region), Church No. 74, and to help with the wiring at **Kakpagyili** (in Tamale), Church No. 68, to get ready for the big Dedication Day on August 10.

I've received a lot of great pictures of the work going on in other places, like <u>Kobori</u> (Overseas No. 2), Church No. 82, where they're plastering the walls, getting ready for flooring, etc.

Right now, we're working very hard all this week and next week, on the printed newsletters. If you haven't been receiving them in the mail twice a year, please let me know. I can send the color version by E-mail or Whatsapp, if you ask.

Be praying for me as I travel soon to the U.S., to minister for several weeks, from May 23-July 10. You can call me there (281-471-4109). I look forward to spending a wonderful week with our amazing son and his family, plus the opportunity to minister in many different places.
