SOME RECENT **TESTIMONIES**

GHANA – I met a lady, after ministering in a large church, and she told me about how Arthur, my beloved late husband, had prayed for her to have a child, when she didn't have one, about twelve years ago. In spite of having a fibroid, she soon got pregnant, and has an eleven year old daughter!

USA - A lady was in a lot of pain before a service, and had suffered all day with it. Jesus touched her, as we prayed, and all the pain disappeared. She was rejoicing, for Jesus is the mighty Healer today!

GHANA – In August, we finished the buildings, and had big dedication services at three more churches we've helped to build in the villages and towns in northern Ghana. They're at Paga Navio (near the border of Ghana and Burkina Faso), then at **Gbeduri**, near Walewale, and at **Diari**, on the Walewale-Tamale road). There was great joy in each place, and lots of grateful people, thanking God for a helping hand.

USA – A young girl in a Christian school, had an assignment to raise funds for a missionary, and she chose me. Many years ago, her Dad, who is from Ghana, lived with us for two years, when he was in High School. She made little bead bracelets to sell, and presented me with \$250 cash for the ministry!

NIGERIA - In Abuja, capital of Nigeria, my good friend, who is a pastor, came to see me, and shared his testimony. He was recently promoted to a very high position in his work at the High Court of Nigeria in Abuja. God lifts up His people, as He said in Psalm 75-6-7, "Promotion is not from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another."

GHANA - A lady testified about how she had written down her prayer points in a service two years ago. God had answered every one of her prayers! She graduated from the University, married a fine man, and now has a child (the first baby boy in her family, after several girls).

<u>USA</u> —A man gives faithfully to the ministry every month, and I prayed for him, while I was talking to him on the phone. Jesus touched his shoulder, and the pains that he had suffered from for a long time were gone. He came to a service to give his testimony, a few days later.

GHANA – We've started helping four more churches to put a roof on their buildings in northern Ghana during the month of August, while I was there. They're at **Biu** in Upper East Region, near Navrongo, Church No. 76; at **Gbimsi**, near Walewale, Church No. 77; at **Bisaldo**, near Saboba and the Togo border, Church No. 78; and at **Kukpalgo**, near Yendi and the Togo border, Church No. 79. At Bisaldo, they finished the roof in six days, and were enjoying the new church on the next Sunday!

<u>NIGER</u> – My good friends, Israel and Esther Olubamisaye, are faithful missionaries from Nigeria for over twelve years. They live in the desert, in the country of Niger, and a very hard place. They spent a day with me recently, while they were at home in Nigeria for a few days. God is using them mightily there, and if you'd like to send offerings to help them, let me know, so I can connect you to them.

Some of these printed newsletters will be mailed in the U.S., as I'll send them in a shipment by air freight from Nigeria to the U.S. Then, faithful friends will put stamps on them, and mail them out. Praise God for putting people to help me, every step of the way!

I had another birthday on August 7, and I'm now 79 years old. We're working on Church No. 79 in northern Ghana, and soon to start on two more!
