I'm still here! This is my eighth country to minister in this year, and five more yet to go. God is so good! I've already been in West Africa, India, and East Africa in 2017, with southern Africa still ahead.

I'll be at home for a few days there, and go to Ghana, where I'll be ministering till the end of August. I'll travel all over the country by road, on good roads and bad roads, to get to villages, towns, and cities.

We'll also dedicate another new church we've helped to build at Nasia, No. 60, completely built by Life Christian University in Miami, Florida. I was there last week to thank them again.

They have a big heart for missions, and have also helped my very dear Nigerian missionary friends in the desert, Israel and Esther Olubamisaye, who minister in the country of Niger, north of Nigeria. Please pray always for them, and their five children. Help them, whenever you can, as they live totally by faith, in a very difficult place, winning Muslims to Jesus, one by one.

This past week, I've sent funds to help three of the new churches in northern Ghana with plastering walls inside and outside, putting in the floor, doors, windows, wiring, etc. Two more are getting the roof on the new buildings this week.

Pray for me, and give as much as you can, as we begin to help three more churches that need roofs and finishing right now. They will be No. 67, No. 68, and No. 69. Can we get to 70 or 80??? Yes, we can!

Testimonies, testimonies! After the service in one place here in Texas, a man came to me, and said, "You've shared so many testimonies and miracles! Look at my wife over there!"

He told me that she had had ovarian cancer, and so many people prayed for her healing. When the doctor started with the surgery, he was so very shocked, to find the cancer wasn't there any more!

I prayed for a lady today, whom I had met by chance, and she was crying, saying that she felt so much better immediately. Praise God! He's at work, as you pray for people, too!
