Hello this afternoon, from the big city of Chennai, India. It's Wednesday, March 8, 2017, and I'm ministering in India for one and a half more weeks, then I'll be in East Africa for six weeks.

Thanks, thanks, thanks, for praying for me as I travel, and for giving faithfully to help support the ministry. God has made you a great blessing to me!

I was in a sleeper bus all night last night, with a mattress to lie on, and sleep the whole way, if possible. It was quite comfortable, and my second time on such a bus in India.

Later this week, I'll be on a double deck train (my first time to ever see a double deck train) to travel to Bangalore, the last place to minister. I have many friends there in Bangalore, and will get to visit in some of their homes.

I've been enjoying India food every day! Some of my favorites are idli, dhosa, biriyani, etc. My husband, Arthur, used to say, "We have international stomachs, so just give us any food!"

Last month, I started in Ghana, then was back home in Nigeria, and came to India. I'll be ministering in thirteen different countries this year, and I really need your prayers daily.

Here in India, as I shared news, pictures, and stories about the churches we're helping to build In northern Ghana, West Africa, a pastor got excited, and raised a wonderful offering from the people who were in the church that day. It will help build another church in a village, praise God!

The roof is on at Diari (Church No. 66) in northern Ghana, and others are still working on theirs, too. The needs are great, and whatever you can do to help me will be appreciate so much.

I'm having a physiotherapist come to help me with exercises whenever and wherever possible. My right wrist is almost fully recovered now.

A Hindu lady has helped me with therapy several different times in one place, and I've talked to her a lot about Jesus. I've prayed with her, too, and gave her a Bible in her language, also two of my books translated into that language. Please be praying for her, as she's learning to pray to Jesus.

God continues to work miracles, and a girl with high fever got healed in one church. The fever just

In another place, a lady got a job, a few hours after I prayed for her. A man who had been drinking a lot for 17 years, gave his life to Jesus, and he doesn't drink alcohol again, praise God.

This past Sunday, a Hindu family all gave their lives to Jesus in the church where I ministered. A pastor's wife gave testimony about how she saw 75 women give their lives to Jesus in a Women's Rally.

Pray for a dear pastor friend, whose church we've ministered in almost every time we've been in India. His lovely wife passed away very suddenly, just before I arrived in India, at the age of 64. I'll be in another church this time, when I go to that city, but pray for him and the family, as it's a great loss.

While I was on the bus last night, a pastor called me from northern Ghana, so excited about several weeks of evangelism in the hard to reach "overseas" area. The pastors opened five new churches in the villages, and they plan to send workers there soon to teach the people. So many received Jesus!

Yes, we're in the month of **MARCH**, and the letter "<u>M</u>" is for <u>March</u>. But "<u>M</u>" is also for <u>Miracles</u>, too, and I'm praying for you to see <u>Miracles in March</u>!
