In a few days, I'll travel out again, leaving for Zambia around the middle of this month. I'll minister there for three weeks, and then I'll go by road to minister in other countries, to Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Botswana, South Africa, etc. Please be praying for me, as I'll be away for two months.

I spent about ten days in Abuja, capital of Nigeria, and ministered almost every day in different places, even in an outdoor meeting. A pastor's family always puts me in a lovely Guest House there, and makes sure I have everything I need, and get to every place I need to go. They're a big blessing!

They have a recording studio, and helped me to record five of my books as audio books. Very soon, I'll have copies of "Words of Healing," "Words of Success," "Words of Wisdom," and "Stories He Loved to Tell, volumes one and two." They'll be available on audio CD's, MP3, on the ministry website (www.hokett.org), and in all the places where I minister.
