Pray for all the people who help me in so many ways, as I stay in their homes, while some travel with me, some help in the services, some take me where I need to go, etc.

In October and November, I'll be ministering in four different countries, and crossing several borders. I really appreciate your faithful prayers, and your faithful giving to the ministry, as I go to many villages, towns, and cities, sharing with the few and the many.

Please continue to pray for my four very important prayer points I always share: God's **Anointing**, God's **Provision**, God's **Protection**, and God's **Strength**. **APPS** prayers make all the difference!

Testimonies are everywhere, and in Abuja, capital of Nigeria, I met my good friend, who has a handsome little son, after a long wait for a second child. Their first son is now fourteen years old!

He's going soon to China, to organize what he needs for a fantastic business idea, and its time has come! After several years of study, preparation, and research, he's ready for serious investors, getting equipment, etc. Please join me to pray for his success, and some divine connections.

Another friend in Abuja (a pastor), came to see me, giving a testimony of his very big promotion a few weeks ago. He has served very faithfully and diligently, in the court system for many years. A few weeks ago, he was promoted to a very high position, to be over the appointing of thousands of people in all the courts of the country! God rewards faithfulness, and He will reward you, too!
