Hello this afternoon from Lagos, as I'm at home here in Nigeria for the past few days now. It's Monday, Sept. 4, 2017, and I praise God for the past over six weeks I spent recently in Ghana.

Thanks for praying for me, as I really need you to faithfully pray for me always. I'll be ministering in Nigeria for the next few weeks, both in Lagos and Abuja. Please remember my four prayer points for many years: <u>God's anointing</u>, <u>God's provision</u>, <u>God's protection</u>, and <u>God's strength</u>.

I'm so grateful for every person who gives, as that's <u>God's provision</u> for the ministry. You're a part, as He uses people just like you all over the world, in Nigeria, Ghana, Kenya, India, Australia, Zambia, U.S., South Africa, Ethiopia, Canada, Tanzania, Botswana, etc., to sow seeds into the work. **THANKS**!

The terrible floods in the Houston area of Texas, where I'm from, have caused a lot of heartache and loss for many thousands of people there. It affected me, personally, as my car had several feet of water in it, as well as the car and house of the family who kept it for me. Please pray for all the people in Houston, who have suffered so much, including homes, businesses, etc.

In Ghana, I ministered in many different places, going everywhere by road. My very faithful driver, whenever I'm there, is a great blessing for over five years now.

In the North, we dedicated another church we've helped to build, at Nasia (Church No. 60). It was a big occasion, with many people present, and a very happy time of praise to God. Thanks again to the teachers and students at Life Christian University in Miami, Florida, who helped build the church, from putting the roof on, and then helping go all the way through, to finishing it.

We also started helping four more new churches, at Tinga (No. 67), at Kpakpagyili, Tamale(No. 68), at Kalbeo, Bolgatanga (No. 69), and at Gingaani (No. 70) The funds to roof the church in Gingaani was totally given to me in offerings from several churches that helped me in Ghana, praise God!

Would you like to help me to do a lot of plastering walls, flooring, windows, doors, wiring, painting, etc., on these churches? Please let me know, as God wants to use **YOU** to have a part!

The work continues, as we help other churches in northern Ghana, at Paga Navio, Gbeduri, Diare, and Bimbago. Two more new churches will be dedicated in January, 2018, when I'm in Ghana again, at Pwalugu and Gambaga. God is so good!

I'm continually amazed at <u>God's provision</u> to help build more churches in northern Ghana! People sometimes ask me if I plan to get to No. 80, 90, or even 100, and I just tell them that we're on the way! The needs are so great, to give a helping hand to churches in so many villages and towns, as I'm doing my best, then God makes it all possible. <u>Truly, when we give God our best, He gives us His best</u>.

The testimonies continue always, and I like to share them, as often as I can. A Nigerian pastor's wife yesterday, testified about how we had prayed for her, quite a few years ago, when she came to help with our newsletters, as a volunteer. We prayed for her business, also for her to

have a life partner, and she's now married to a pastor, plus they have three fine sons!

A lady gave a testimony of how she was walking on the street, and suddenly had a blackout spell. She managed to sit down somewhere, and prayed, "Jesus, Jesus, Jesus, please help me," till it passed.

Another person was counting money needed to pay for something, and it was quite short every time. As he prayed, suddenly it became the correct amount! I've seen that happen myself, as God supplies!

Pray for me in Nigeria for the next few weeks, ministering in Lagos and Abuja, before I travel out again to the southern part of Africa. We're working very hard on the 2018 "Thought for the Day" calendar to be printed this month, plus all the printed newsletters to mail out in October.
