SOME RECENT TESTIMONIES

GHANA – We dedicated two more churches in August, churches you've helped me build in northern Ghana. The first was at Kologo, on August 12, and the second was at Kukua, Tamale, on August 13. Thanks to every person who is having a part in the ministry!

<u>NIGERIA</u> – A lady in Abuja, capital of Nigeria, testified a few days ago, about how she had written down her prayer points, when I ministered in her church last year. One was a healing of her memory, as she was always forgetting things she needed to remember. She had a terrible fear of dementia and Alzheimer's. Now, God has done it, and her memory is normal again.

<u>USA</u> – A lady in a church where I was ministering in the month of June, got healed as I prayed! She hadn't been able to lift her arm up over her head for over a year. Now she can do it!

GHANA – We had a double service at the second new church we dedicated in northern Ghana in August. In March, I saw her new car in front of her house!

In Abuja, Nigeria, a pastor and his wife always put me in a nice Guest House when I'm ministering in their church and others. They assign people to help me in every way, also take me to every place I need to go.

In Zambia, three different families host me in their homes, and in Swaziland, I stay with a wonderful lady; in Botswana, I've stayed with several families; while in South Africa, I stay in the lovely home of a businessman from Zimbabwe. I stay in homes with good friends in Kenya, Uganda, Ethiopia, India, etc. God has touched the hearts of His people, to be a great blessing to me!
