I'm also ministering in the Lagos area and in <u>Abuja</u>, capital of Nigeria, too.

Thanks so very, very much for your prayers and giving, which keep me going! Your faithfulness to be a part of the ministry is a big blessing! I also pray for  $\underline{YOU}$ , the ones who've been partners for many years, and the new ones that God is adding.

I came from **Ghana** a few days ago, after finishing up six and a half weeks of ministry all over the country, going everywhere by road. My trusty vehicle there is twenty years old, but never had a problem, even on bad roads, with lots of potholes! I thank God for His **protection**, everywhere I go!

The driver I used the whole time did very well, driving and also helping me every day in so many ways. My very faithful regular driver of many years is now recovering well from a badly broken leg, after his terrible accident over three months ago. A big truck went out of control, crushing the driver's side of the vehicle he was driving! He's a **living miracle**, for surviving such a horrible crash!

Please be praying with me for <u>my new book</u> (<u>No. 16</u>), which I hope to publish before I travel out again in <u>October</u>. It's the story of my life, and full of many, many amazing miracles I've seen! I hope you can get a copy someday!

Last month, on August 7, I celebrated **my 80<sup>th</sup> birthday**, while I was ministering in **Ghana**. It was a great day, and I was in **Walewale**, the first place we lived in **Ghana**. I shared nice goat meat and jollof rice with all my visitors that day. I praise God for keeping me going all these years!

Testimonies in <u>Ghana</u> included a young lady, telling me that after I prayed for her last year, Jesus healed her knee. She had suffered with <u>a bad and painful knee</u>, every time she played in sports. Now, her knee is fine, and there's no more problem with sports!

In **Ghana**, we dedicated four of the churches we're helping to build in so many villages and towns in the **North**. First, in **Tinga**, where the people had constructed a small road, so vehicles could drive to the church. Even the **Member of Parliament** for that whole area was an honored guest!

Then, we dedicated the second church at <u>Gorogo</u>, not far from the town of <u>Tongo</u>, where there's a big shrine for an important god. There's fascinating big rock formations near the new church. The third dedication was in <u>Kakpagyili</u>, in a new section of <u>Tamale</u>. The church members worked hard to put tiles on the floor, and to put in a nice ceiling, after I did all I could to help finish the church.

The last dedication was at **<u>Bisaldo</u>**, near <u>**Saboba**</u>, and the <u>**Togo**</u> border. Even the chief is a member of the church! The village doesn't have electricity, but they used a generator that day, and the people were so happy! After the service was dismissed, they came back to sing and dance some more!

We started helping two more churches to put a roof on, at <u>Chuchiliga</u> (No. 85) and <u>Gbankoni</u> (<u>No. 86</u>). Right now, they're putting the wood and steel in place, to soon put on the iron roofing sheets. There are more churches to help, when the funds are there, as God provides.

God is faithful, and the Bible says, "Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall give thee

the desires of thine heart" (<u>Psalm 37:4</u>). Yes, <u>September</u> begins with the letter " $\underline{S}$ ," but the word "<u>SUCCESS</u>" also begins with the letter " $\underline{S}$ " too. I'm praying for you to see <u>SUCCESS</u> in this month of <u>SEPTEMBER</u>! Love, Doris Hokett
